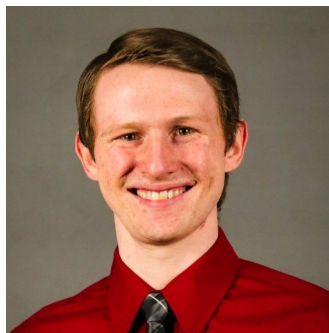


Board Members
