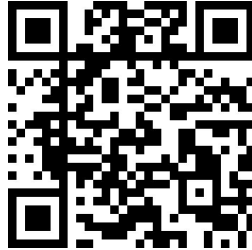

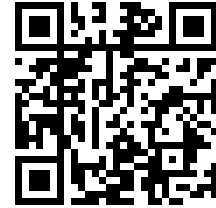


Your donations buy:
